Text: 2 Conntnians 12:2-9 (p.970)
Very often God waits for us to pray and act in before He does what He's going to do on the earth. (James 4:2)
It's a truth that we struggle with. And one of the reasons I believe we struggle is a lingering that we don't often acknowledge in church.

Paul didn't just pray; he
