## God Still Speaks

**Text: John 10:1-5**

“What’s \_\_\_\_\_?” is the question – PERIOD!

**Each one of us can know what \_\_\_\_\_.**

How can we, when looking at the cross and the empty tomb, how can we doubt that He wants us to have \_\_\_\_\_?

**(Jn. 10:10; Rm. 8:31-32)**

Have we learned to hear – really hear – the Shepherd’s voice so He can lead us? And not just lead us, but lead us to the place of \_\_\_\_\_?

Not all who believe God speaks today are \_\_\_\_\_ or abusive.
